Annual Report 2019-2020

The centre has 11 Physically challenged students and 13 Visually Challenged students.

The Sarah's Steps went another milestone of organizing a computer skill development programmenamed "The Educational Needs for the Visually Impaired" for the students of our college from 15.07.2019 with Karna Vidya Foundation. Nine of our students are benefitted through this year long programme. The Students were also tested on their progress on 21.01.2020.

The Centre has a resource room under construction with rest room and ramp. Presently the Communication lab has been facilitated with NVDA software on 12 computers for the usage of the visually challenged students.

The Centre also helps students to apply for Government and non-Government scholarships. 11 of our students have got scholarship worth Rs 1,70,000 from the Help the Blind Foundation.

The visually Challenged students were taken for an eye check-up camp on 29th August 2019 at the Blind School organized by Agarwal Eye Hospital. 13 students were benefitted through this.

As per the proposal to start special courses on Commerce and Computer Science for the Deaf and Dumb students is being sent to the University and a special block is under construction for that purpose.

Evangeline of III B.Com. has been presented the Best Sarah Award for her outstanding performance in academics.
