About 20 students with different disabilities



enrolled themselves. Now the centre has enrolled 10 Visually Challenged, 4 Physically Challenged, 2 with Cerebral Disorders and 4 with LD. The centre was inaugurated on 17th July 2017 by the District Collector, Mr. Sandeep Nandoori. Mrs. Vijila Sathyanand, Member of Parliament was also Present. A room was allocated by the management for the centre and a computer also was provided to set up the digital library for these students.
