Free sugar level test was done for all the teaching and non-teaching members of the institution. The medical team from

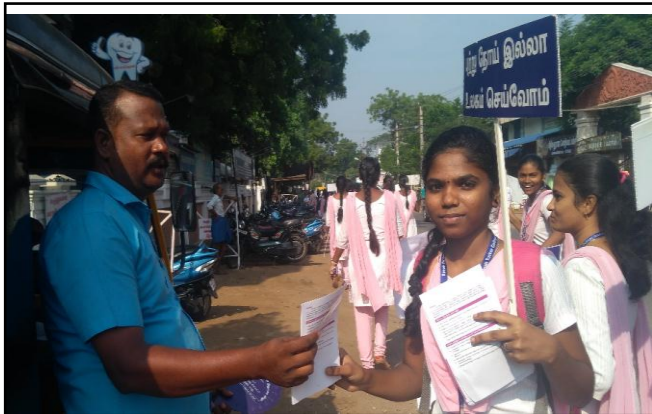
